

# Historic Castlemaine

Years after its prosperous gold mining days passed, Castlemaine has established itself as a town with a thriving agricultural, arts and tourism industry.



Today we are taken on a **Tour** of an authentic goldfields house, the **Buda Historic Home & Gardens**. Built in 1861, the Buda still retains its Italianate façade. Afterwards, take a stroll around their 1.2 hectare surrounding gardens.

**The Cumberland Hotel** is one of the largest hotels in the gold fields region. We'll enjoy good old fashioned country hospitality, as we eat our 2-course lunch.



Starting as the Castlemaine Woollen Mill in 1875, and finishing as Victoria Carpets in 2013, **The Mill** is transforming into a place for food and artisan manufacturing, a part of Castlemaine's vibrancy.

The Mill offers something for everyone. Visit the food precinct, with individual small businesses: café, coffee roastery, wine, ice-cream, bread, cakes, beer, the artisan precinct, that includes furniture makers and metal craftsmen and finally the vintage precinct – home of Castlemaine's Vintage Bazaar and Platform No. 5, offering stallholder market-style spaces to sell vintage, re-purposed, hand-made and second hand goods



We finish our day at the **Shedshaker Brewing Company**, for tastings of their brews. Their staff will share their knowledge on every brew that you taste. For those are not wanting to taste their brews, their will be ciders to taste as well.
